

**Oh. That Church. Part Four: Calling to Worship**  
**July 22, 2018**

1. God deserves worship (1 Chronicles 16:25,29; 29:11; Psalm 96:4; Colossians 1:16; Revelation 4:1)
2. God expects worship (Matthew 4:9-10 cf Deuteronomy 6:13; John 4:23)
  - In the end, all people will worship Him (Psalm 86:9; Revelation 15:4)
  - He calls us to worship Him in the way he prescribes (Matthew 15:9; John 4:24; 1 Corinthians 4:24-25; Hebrews 12:28)
    - ✓ Sacrifice (Genesis 22:5; Luke 9:23-24; Romans 12:1)
    - ✓ Belief (John 9:35-38)
    - ✓ Serving the true God and rejecting all others (Deuteronomy 11:16; Psalm 96:4-5; Matthew 4:9-10; Acts 10:24-27; 14:8-18; Revelation 22:8)
    - ✓ Exclusive awe (Isaiah 43:11)
    - ✓ Sincere love (John 4:23-24; Deuteronomy 11:13)
    - ✓ Gratitude (Job 1:21; Psalm 138:2; Habakkuk 3:17-18)

Worship is the exclusive, sincere, obedient expression of reverence to God.

(though it may affect you emotionally, worship is not how you feel about God)

3. Worship is a way of life (1 Corinthians 10:31)
