Part Three: Waiting on God

Hebrews 10:32-39

1. Struggle is a built-in part of Christian experience (10:32-33)
 - Just because we're enlightened doesn't mean we're exempt.
 - We suffer doubly – as human beings and as Christians.
2. If we respond properly, our struggles should produce compassion and contentment (10:34)
 - Struggle can produce self-pity and jealousy (see Psalm 73)
 - The antidote for self-pity is compassion.
 - The antidote for jealousy is contentment
3. Our faith enables us to patiently wait for Christ's return (10:35-39)
 - Our future reward includes 'possessions' that are superior and enduring.
 - This helps us hold on to our trust in God.
 - We know Christ coming is certain, even though it seems delayed.
 - One evidence we belong to Christ is our enduring faith.
