1. Conflict between Christians can hinder the progress of the gospel (4:2-3)
 - Even committed believers can have trouble getting along
 - In some cases, these situations require the help of a peacemaker.
2. Getting along with others requires some key personal disciplines (4:4-7)
 - Rejoicing in the Lord.
 - Developing a reputation for reasonableness.
 - Treating your anxiety with prayer.
3. A lifestyle of obedience requires a transformed thought life (4:8-9)
4. The secret of being content during hardship is depending on Christ's strength (4:10-13)
5. When we sacrifice financially for the sake of the gospel, we can trust God to meet our needs (4:14-20)
