

The Triumph of God's Grace - Part Three: Transformed
2 Corinthians 3 January 15, 2023

1. Genuine believers are a letter from Christ authenticating the credentials of those who serve the new covenant (3:1-3)
2. God is the only one who can qualify someone be a servant of the new covenant (3:4-6)
 - No one is qualified to serve this ministry in themselves.
 - Unlike the old covenant, the new covenant brings life.
3. The glory of the old covenant pales in comparison with the glory of the new covenant (3:7-11)
 - Though it could only bring condemnation, the old covenant reflected God's glory.
 - The incredible glory of the new covenant is that it provides permanent righteousness (Hebrews 10:1-4, 12-17)
4. Because they turned to the Lord, believers are transformed to reflect God's glory (3:12-18)
 - For some people, the glory of the new covenant is covered by a veil of unbelief.
 - When a person turns to the Lord, they experience the freedom of seeing God's glory in Christ.
 - Because of this, the Holy Spirit transforms them so they reflect God's glory more and more.
