Turning Points Part Six: Set In Stone Exodus 19, Deuteronomy 5, Galatians 3 November 19, 2023

- 1. After the Exodus, the Law was given to Moses on Mt Sinai (Exodus 19:10-11,16,19-20)
- 2. The Mosaic Law was a constitution for God's covenant people (Exodus 19:3-6)
 - It contained civil, ceremonial, and moral components.
 - It rests on the 10 commandments.
- 3. The Law was given to reveal that it's impossible for us to live up to God's righteous standards.
 - It condemned everyone and justified no one (Romans 3:19-20)
 - It was a temporary measure until Abraham's perfect offspring came (Galatians 3:18-19)
- 4. Because of what Christ accomplished, we are no longer under the Law of Moses (Galatians 3:24-25)
- 5. Both formerly and now, salvation is only received by faith, not law-keeping.
 - Salvation through law-keeping requires perfection (Galatians 3:10-11; James 2:10)
 - The righteousness God requires can only be received through faith (Romans 4:13-17)
