1. If you measure your life by your possessions, you break the tenth commandment (Luke 12:13-15)
2. Material prosperity can result in spiritual poverty (Luke 12:16-21)
3. Dealing with anxiety means adopting the following principles (Luke 12:22-31)
 - There is way more to life than just possessions (Luke 12:22-23)
 - You matter to God (Luke 12:24)
 - There are many things over which you have no control (Luke 12:25-26)
 - Since God cares for the most insignificant of his creation, you can trust Him to care for you (Luke 12:27-28)
 - Put your best energy toward seeking God's kingdom and let Him 'worry' about meeting your needs (Luke 12:29-31)
4. Your heart will love what you treasure most (Luke 12:32-34)
