I Am Your God Part One: White as Snow Isaiah 1:1-20 March 3, 2024

- 1. Despite his care for them, Israel forsook the Lord (1:1-6)
 - God chose Abraham's descendants as His covenant people.
 - Their actions displayed contempt for their good God.
- 2. Israel was suffering the consequences of their sin (1:7-9)
- 3. Their hypocritical worship offended the Lord (1:10-15)
- 4. Repentance was the only acceptable response to the Lord's rebuke (1:16-20)
 - Repentance for salvation is a one-time change of heart regarding sin and God.
 - Outwardly, it results in forsaking sin and pursuing good.
 - Inwardly, it results in a right relationship with God.
 - Whether they repented would determine their future.
