Part Four: Counted Righteous
Isaiah 42:1-4 & 53
April 7, 2024

1. God the Father promised to bring justice to the earth through his Servant (Isaiah 42:1-4)
 - The Father delights in him (42:1)
 - The Father will direct him through the Spirit (42:1)
 - He will bring justice without crushing the weak (42:2-3)
 - He will not quit until justice is achieved (42:4)
2. As part of his plan to bring justice to the earth, God the Father ordained the suffering of his Servant (Isaiah 53:1-12)

Regarding this Servant, Isaiah wrote that:

 - This plan would be hard to believe (53:1)
 - No one would be impressed by his appearance (53:2)
 - People would despise him (53:3)
 - He would suffer because of our sin (53:4-6)
 - He would willingly submit to the ultimate injustice (53:7-9)
 - This would fulfill the will of the Father (53:10)
 - Many would be counted righteous (53:11)
 - Afterward, the Father would reward his Servant (53:12)
