  - Jehoram, the ungodly king of Israel (2 Kings 5:6-7)
  - Elijah, the confident prophet of God (2 Kings 5:8-10,15-19,25-27)
  - Gehazi, the greedy servant (2 Kings 5:19-27)
- 2. The story of Naaman teaches valuable lessons about God and human motivation.
  - Naaman He had to swallow his pride to experience God's blessing.
  - The girl Her small act of faith set the stage for a great act of God.
  - Jehoram Because of his rebellion against God, he was unprepared to face a fearful situation.
  - Elijah He sought God's glory, not his own.
  - Gehazi Despite proximity to a man of God, he was a man of greed.
