1. Christ ended our frustrating inability to meet God's righteous requirements (Romans 10:1-5)
 - If you know Christ, you'll long for those you love to know him too.
 - Some people want to please God, but they don't know how.
 - Because of this, they follow their own path to being a good person.
 - The only way to satisfy God is to be perfect. Christ met that expectation for us.
2. The righteousness Christ provides is revealed in the message of the gospel (Romans 10:6-8)
 - It's not an unattainable mystery that's hard to find.
 - It's available to everyone who will believe the gospel.
3. A Christian is someone who confesses that Jesus is Lord and believes that God raised him from the dead (Romans 10:10-13)
 - The verbal confession flows from a believing heart.
 - It's available to anyone.
 - It results in salvation.
