Reality Check Part Two: Authentically Christian Romans 10:1-13 November 3, 2024

- 1. Christ ended our frustrating inability to meet God's righteous requirements (Romans 10:1-5)
 - If you know Christ, you'll long for those you love to know him too.
 - Some people want to please God, but they don't know how.
 - Because of this, they follow their own path to being a good person.
 - The only way to satisfy God is to be perfect. Christ met that expectation for us.
- 2. The righteousness Christ provides is revealed in the message of the gospel (Romans 10:6-8)
 - It's not an unattainable mystery that's hard to find.
 - It's available to everyone who will believe the gospel.
- 3. A Christian is someone who confesses that Jesus is Lord and believes that God raised him from the dead (Romans 10:10-13)
 - The verbal confession flows from a believing heart.
 - It's available to anyone.
 - It results in salvation.
