Unshakeable Hebrews 12 December 29, 2024

- 1. Continue the legacy of faithful endurance (12:1-2)
 - You are a uniquely blessed part of a long line of faithful believers (1, cf. 11:39-40)
 - Don't let sin break your stride (1)
 - Follow Jesus' example of joy-inspired endurance (2)
- 2. Accept hardship as part of God's training process (12:3-11)
- 3. Don't be careless about sin (12:12-17)
 - One way or another, it will cripple you (12-13)
 - This means:
 - ✓ Pursuing peace (13)
 - ✓ Pursuing sanctification (13)
 - ✓ Clinging to God's grace so you don't get bitter (15)
 - ✓ Believing that a pattern of willful sin indicates you don't know God (16-17)
- 4. Stand on what you've "seen" by faith (12:18-24)
 - Under Moses' leadership, God's people were given visible yet fearful evidence of his presence (18-21)
 - What we have from God is not yet visible, but we know it's far more incredible (22-24)
- 5. Gratefully worship God because you have a place in His unshakeable kingdom (12:25-29)
