Church on Purpose Part Four: Exalting Psalm 63 March 23, 2025

- 1. Worship begins with choosing to seek God (63:1)
 - It takes effort.
 - It's driven by deep spiritual and physical longing.
- 2. We worship God by: (Psalm 63:2-8)
 - Going to the sanctuary, that place dedicated to displaying his power and glory (2)
 - Developing a habit of praising him for his covenant love (3-4)
 - Satisfying our soul-hunger in him (5a)
 - Harnessing our thoughts to remember and meditate on the ways he's helped us (5b-7)
 - Replacing self-reliance with God-reliance (8)
- 3. Worship requires trusting the justice of God (Psalm 63:9-11)
 - Mistreatment will either hinder or deepen worship.
 - We can count on God to deal with those who perpetrate evil against us.
 - Leaving justice to God gives us room to rejoice despite mistreatment.
