- 1. God is the only one who is truly free.
 - He is self-existent (John 1:4; 5:24).
 - He is the source of all things (Isaiah 44:24)
 - He has authority over all things (Matthew 28:18; Romans 13:1)
 - He is not indebted to anyone (Job 41:11)
- 2. From the time we are born, we're not free.
 - We are born with a sin nature (Romans 7:18-20)
 - Our sin nature causes us to be sin addicts (John 8:34; Ecclesiastes 7:20)
 - Our sin separates us from God (Ephesians 2:1-3)
- 3. When we believe in Jesus, we find true freedom.
 - We're free from sin's total control (Romans 6:6-7)
 - We're free to please God (Romans 6:17-18)
 - We no longer belong to the world (John 15:19)
 - We enjoy the true freedom of belonging to God (1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 7:23; Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 2:9)
- 4. Believers are called to resist the influence of the world (Romans 6:19; 12:2; Titus 2:14)
