1. Despite his clear promises, no one expected Jesus to rise from the dead (Luke 24:1)
2. Hearing the angels quote Jesus' words jogged the women's memory of what he had promised (Luke 24:8)
3. Don't be surprised by people's skepticism about Jesus' resurrection (Luke 24:11)
4. When Jesus wanted to validate his identity, he pointed them to the Scriptures (Luke 24:27,44-47)
5. Without God's help, no one can recognize Jesus for who he is (Luke 24:16,31)
6. Jesus' resurrection was not spiritual, but physical (Luke 24:36-43)
7. The gospel is at the core of Jesus' mission and message (Luke 24:46-47)
8. When you encounter the living Jesus, you'll want to tell others (Luke 24:33-34,48)
