1. Because they turned their back on him, God allowed Judah to be conquered by Babylon (Daniel 1:2)

Application:

- God can bring harsh judgment on entire nations.
- Faithfulness to God doesn't guarantee that he'll spare you from hardship.
- 2. King Nebuchadnezzar implemented a leadership training program for some of the captives (Daniel 1:3-7)

Application:

- God can accomplish his purpose through you despite oppressive circumstances.
- 3. At great personal risk, Daniel resolved that he would not violate God's law (Daniel 1:8-16) Application:
 - Comfort can breed compromise.
 - Obedience is a non-negotiable aspect of devotion to God.
 - Costly obedience requires leaving the outcome to God.
- 4. God responded by protecting and elevating Daniel and his four companions (1:17-21) Application:
 - Heeding God's commands doesn't guarantee future success or recognition.
 - Your obedience will position you so God can bless you for it.
