Christ and Culture Part Five: When the Heat is On Daniel 3 May 4, 2025

- 1. King Nebuchadnezzar commissioned a golden image as a test of devotion for his government officials (Daniel 3:1-7)
 - Significance: All governments compel behavior. The danger is when they compel devotion.
- 2. Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah defiance of the king's order provided the perfect opportunity for some wicked officials to try to take them down (Daniel 3:8-12)
 - Significance: Don't be surprised if people malign you for not being devoted to their 'gods.'
- 3. Nebuchadnezzar was enraged at their refusal to bend to his authority (Daniel 3:13-15) Significance: If you live God's truth, you will get pushback.
- 4. The men refused the king's offer of a second chance (Daniel 3:16-18) Significance:
 - When you are truly devoted to God, you can stand against the most fearful threats.
 - This type of devotion must be determined ahead of time.
- 5. God miraculously delivered the men while they were still in the furnace, causing Nebuchadnezzar to decree that no one could speak ill of their God (Daniel 3:19-30) Significance:
 - One of the most Christ-like things you will ever do is suffer like he did.
 - If you're a believer, the Lord will be with you regardless of the fire.
 - Jesus went through the fire of death for so we could escape eternal death in the fires of hell.
