One Another – Part Two: With All Due Respect 1 Samuel 26 June 8, 2025

- 1. For a second time, King Saul and his troops searched to capture and kill David, heir apparent to the throne of Israel (1 Samuel 26:1-5)
- 2. Because of his respect for Saul's role as king, David passed up a golden opportunity to eliminate this dangerous enemy (1 Samuel 2:6-12)
- 3. David's act of respect toward Saul dampened his desire to harm him (1 Samuel 26:13-25)

Underlying Principle: Romans 13:7

Pay to all what is owed to them:...respect to whom respect is owed, honor to whom honor is owed.

7 Bible-Based Respect Obligations

- 1. Respect God for his perfections and for his role as God (1 Peter 3:15; Rev. 4:11; John 5:22-23)
- 2. Respect everyone as made in God's image (James 3:8-9; 1 Peter 2:17)
- 3. Respect the role of those in civil authority over you (Romans 13:1)
- 4. Respect believers as fellow members of God's family (Romans 12:10)
- 5. Respect the role of spiritual leaders (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13)
- 6. Respect the role of your father and mother (Matthew 19:19)
- 7. Respect of a wife for the role of her husband (Ephesians 5:33)
