1. The leaders of Israel were completely unaware of the Lord's impending judgment (Ezekiel 11:1-4)
 - They carelessly spent their time plotting their sinful actions and giving wicked advice.
 - They falsely believed they were safe.
2. The Lord decreed judgment against His people because of their blatant disregard for his requirements (Ezekiel 11:5-13)
 - They had no regard for human life.
 - They feared conquest, yet they didn't seek the Lord's favor.
 - They lived just like the other evil nations around them.
 - Ezekiel feared this was the end of God's chosen people.
3. Despite this judgment, one day the Lord will again bless His people (Ezekiel 11:14-21)
 - Until then he will provide sanctuary for the faithful remnant.
 - He will give them the land of Israel once more.
 - He will give them a new heart and a new spirit.
4. The beginning of the present judgment was marked by the glory of the Lord departing from Jerusalem (Ezekiel 11:22-25)
