## Encounters with Jesus Part One: A Perplexing Pronouncement John 3:1-18 December 7, 2025

- 1. Nicodemus was a sincere Pharisee who wanted to know who Jesus was (John 3:1-2)
  - We don't know why he came to Jesus at night.
  - Jesus' miracles convinced him that he was sent by God.
- 2. Instead of explaining who he was, Jesus told Nicodemus that to see God's kingdom, he had to be born again (John 3:3-8)
  - Nicodemus had no idea what Jesus meant.
  - We all need 2 births—physical and spiritual
  - As with the wind, we can't observe it with our eyes but we can see the effects.
- 3. As a teacher of the Scriptures, Nicodemus should have understood what Jesus meant (John 3:9-13)
  - He failed to receive the testimony that God gave through his Word.
  - Jesus, the Son of Man, came from heaven to reveal these truths.
- 4. God sent his Son so we could be saved through him (John 3:14-18)
  - Moses' serpent on a pole pictures the Son of God on the cross.
  - Sending his Son was the premiere way in which God demonstrated his love for us.
