

Walk by Faith
Part One: Looking to the Reward
Hebrews 11:23-28

1. From beginning to end, the Christian life is a life of faith (Habakkuk 3:14; Romans 1:16-17)
 - We're saved by faith (justification)
 - We live by faith (sanctification)
 - We know we will see Jesus by faith (glorification)
2. To help us, God's Word provides examples of living by faith (Hebrews 6:12)
 - We'll do better at living by faith if we imitate them.
 - Living by faith requires endurance.
3. Moses is an example of living by faith (Hebrews 11:23-28)
 - By faith, his parents risked their lives to keep him alive (11:23 – also see Exodus 1:15-22)
 - By faith, Moses:
 - ✓ Chose mistreatment over comfort (11:24-26)
 - ✓ Left Egypt at great risk because he had his eyes on God (11:27)
 - ✓ Obeyed God in a way that must have seemed ridiculous (11:28)
4. Three truths about a living-by-faith mindset.
 - We're willing to take risks to do what's right.
 - We value the hardships of obedience over the comforts of disobedience.
 - We determine to obey God, even when we don't understand why.
